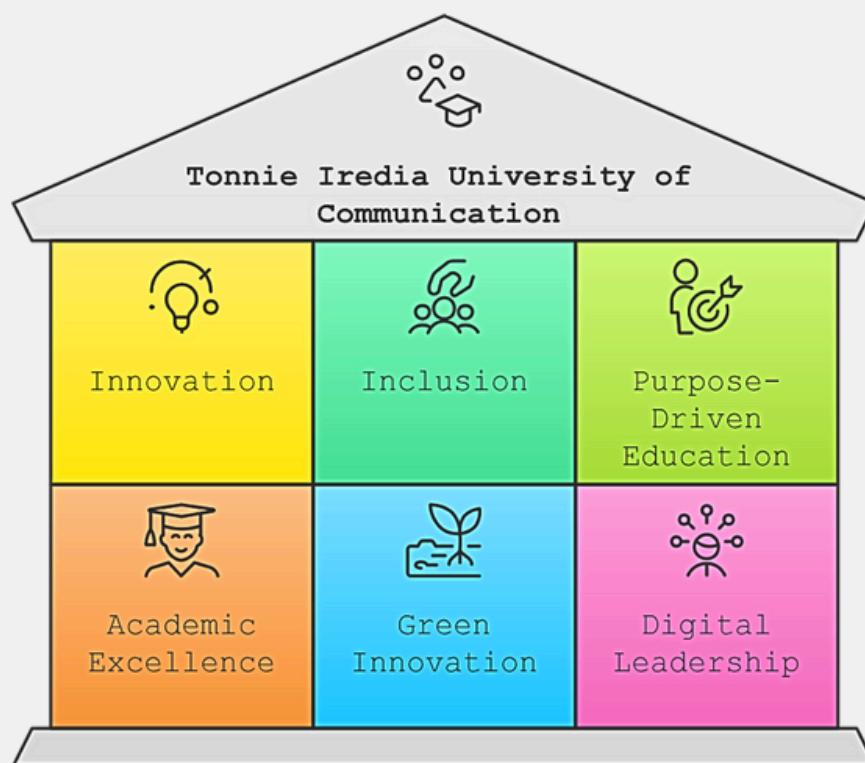
Our Vision & Mission

TIUC is committed to producing globally competent communicators and creators who lead, inspire, and transform society through academic excellence, green innovation, and digital leadership.



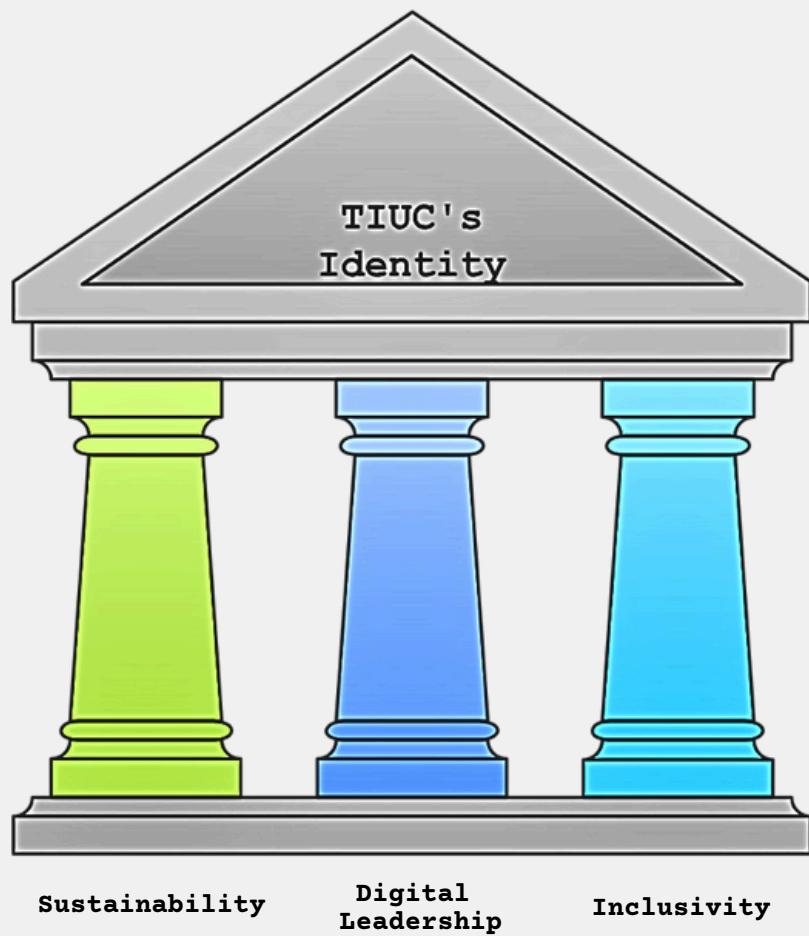
